Third Annual MAPCR Realtime Contest

The test will be five minutes of literary material dictated at varying speeds from 180 to 200 words per minute. Any writer of shorthand who is a member of MAPCR in good standing for the preceding two years is eligible to compete. Please register on the convention registration form. Per NCRA, qualifiers are eligible to receive .4 CEUs. An individual may only receive a maximum of .5 CEUs per three-year NCRA cycle for any contests. Other contest rules and regulations will be provided at the convention. The fee is \$25 and must be paid by the registration deadline. There will be no onsite registration.
